PRIVACY / COLLECTION STATEMENT

General

This privacy / collection statement sets out how we collect, use and maintain any personal information that we hold about you. It also broadly sets out the details of your privacy rights and the general privacy rights of MDC Limited and its obligations attached to keeping personal information about you on our records.

Your Privacy

Your privacy is of utmost importance to us. We are committed to ensuring that your privacy is respected and maintained at all times and we comply with the Privacy Act 1993.

Personal Information

Personal information is any information or opinion about you which may include, amongst other things, references, medical history, employment history, qualifications, contact details, citizenship, residency status, working rights, etc.

Collection of Personal Information

Your personal information will be collected by one of our consultants who may require it to assist them in finding a placement for you. All personal information collected will be held securely at our offices and may be accessed by our employees.

Method of collection

Your personal information may be collected from you during interview stage with one of our consultants and by the completion of our registration paperwork. Information about you may also be collected when we take your references, verify your working rights in New Zealand, receive your results of any competency test undertaken, performance feedback or by way of a response to a job advertisement.

Our website

Candidate registration via our website and on-line registration with MDC Ltd will also allow us to collect personal information about you which you voluntarily give us by using our website for registration purposes. This information may also include your full name, address, phone number, email address etc. All information gathered this way is stored on our data base for retrieval and use

by our consultants. By sending us your personal information this way, you acknowledge and accept our Privacy / Collection Statement.

Disclosure of Information

We will not disclose any information about you that you provide to us through our registration process unless authorised by you to do so or unless required by law. Your personal information may be disclosed to:

- Potential and current employers;
- Referees;
- Consultants of MDC Limited;
- Our insurers;
- Any government department for verification of working rights;

Use of Personal Information

Your personal information may be used in connection with the following:

- Any activities regarding actual or possible work placements;
- Verification of your working rights in New Zealand;
- Internal audit and quality processes

Consent

We will advise you of our intentions and gain your prior consent before we refer your personal information to our clients for possible employment opportunities.

Protection of your personal information

We will take all reasonable steps to ensure the protection of your personal information from being misused, lost, modified or incorrectly disclosed. Adequate safety measures will be put in place to protect your personal information such as the storing of your information in a secure manner and on a computerised data base. Access to our data base is only available to those who require access and all our staff are bound by a confidentiality agreement regarding our candidate and company information.

Access to and correction of information

Upon being so informed, we will take all reasonable steps to correct or rectify any incorrect information that we may hold about you.
